**Item 4 Review SIP (School Improvement Plan) results. Dr. Connie Collins**

Dr. Collins also reviewed the 2007-2008 SIP objectives and stated there were 19 objectives. If 9 of 19 objectives are made, it will be considered as passing. Dr. Collins informed us that Crooms now has an online SAT prep program. All Crooms students received a logon.

Dr. Collins described the process for determining how A+ school bonus money was going to be distributed.
