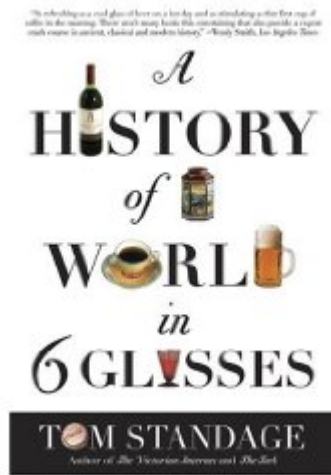


Summer Assignment (2010-2011)

AP World History

1. Read Chapter 1-3 of Earth and its Peoples and complete breakdowns for each chapter (see attached format). **REQUIRED**
2. Acquire and read A History of the World in 6 Glasses by Tom Standage.
REQUIRED



- Students will need to represent the six themes (depicted by drinks) in a 3-D display with attached written analysis.

3-D Display

The display will visually exemplify the six themes (no bottles of alcohol please) in a creative manner. This may entail symbolic representations. Additionally, students will attach a one-page written explanation of the display of the themes.

AP WH Chapter Breakdown Format

1. Important people: who are the most important historical figures in this time period? Where are they from? Why are they significant? When did they live?
2. Important places: what are the most important cities or regions in this period? Where are they located? Why are they significant? How did they contribute to interaction and exchange?
3. Important Works of Literature and/or Art: what does it reveal about the pertinent culture or time period?
4. Items Exchanged between Regions (if applicable)
5. Turning points: were there major events that had a significant impact on future events? What were they? What were the causes and effects?
6. Changes-over-time: what changed over time, both within a specific region and between regions? How did it change since previous chapters?
7. Continuities-over-time: what stayed the same over time, both within a specific region and between regions?
8. Summary/Reaction: in 1-2 paragraphs, summarize the major events of this chapter, and provide a written reaction to this chapter. Do not provide vague, generalized comments such as, “wow, this was a great chapter; the content affected me on an emotional level.” Provide specific, genuine reactions.
